



## AARON BOYCE MEMORIAL GREATER BIRMINGHAM 7'S TOURNAMENT

On Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> May, The Aaron Boyce Memorial Greater Birmingham 7s Rugby Tournament will take place at Moseley RFC's Billesley Common Ground at 10.30am.

May 2007 marks the second anniversary of the untimely death of Aaron Boyce (16) a young Moseley Rugby Player. To commemorate the gifted young player and raise funds for the selected charity, the Guide Dogs for the Blind Association, the successful tournament (raising an impressive total in excess of £7,700 last year) will take place once again with the support of local rugby clubs; Moseley and Selly Oak as well as the Greater Birmingham RFU.

The tournament proves to be an eventful one. In addition to the rugby matches taking place on four pitches with local and visiting teams, there will be extensive off field family entertainment being held throughout the day, with the event culminating with Fat Ankles, an Oasis tribute band, playing in the club house in the evening.

Tournament Organiser Ben Jowett said: "We are confident that 2007 will be even more successful than last year's tournament. As well as club members from all our competing sides, family and friends, we hope to welcome local residents from around the area. We hope that the great efforts made by many of the Boyce's family and friends at both Selly Oak and Moseley Rugby Clubs will be rewarded by attendance and generous giving on the day and look forward to another highly successful event."
